Story A Banker in Yokohama, Japan, when the war broke out, Lieutenant Kerr returned home and early in the war enlisted in the 16th HLI. After his death, the Major of his Battalion in a letter to his father, wrote: "Your son's Company, "A", was the directing one in the main attack in the battle of the Somme, and he was last seen gallantly leading his platoon into the enemy trenches. What actually happened in the trenches we cannot say, as no one came back."
